## **Code of Conduct**

All Local Authorities including Community and Town Council were required to adopt the new Code of Conduct which all their members are required to sign and adopt when becoming a member of the community council. Llanelly Community Council members adopted the new Code of Conduct on Monday 9 May 2016, The Local Authorities Model Code of Conduct as amended April 2016.

The Code of Conduct requires locally elected members register and declare any personal or prejudicial interests they may have in business of the Community Council, to promote the Ten General Principles Llanelly Community Council members need to consider. Selflessness, Honesty and Integrity, Objectivity, Accountability, Openness, Personal Judgement, Respect for Others, Duty to Uphold the Law, Stewardship, Leadership.

This will provide confidence to local residents that expected high standards of ethical behaviour and to prevent any maladministration.
