## Notice of Co-Option

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a number of seats in the Gilwern ward become vacant following the resignation of two councillors.
2. Nominations to fill the vacancies will be **by co-option**.
3. Expressions of interest are sought from members of the public who meet the following qualifications and are interested in representing their community on the aforementioned Community Council. You must be British, Commonwealth, Irish or a European Union citizen and be 18 years of age or over; and meet at least one of the following criteria:
  - *registered as a local government elector for the area named above; or*
  - *during the whole of the last 12 months occupied as owner or tenant, land or other premises in the community named above; or*
  - *your principal or only place of work during the last 12 months has been in the community named above; or*
  - *you have during the whole of the last 12 months resided in the Community or within 4.8 kilometres of it.*
4. Any person willing to fill these vacancies should apply to the Clerk in writing on or before the **12 Noon on the 3 August 2018**.
5. The applicant must not be disqualified from standing as a Councillor.

*\* In computing any period of time for this purpose, a Saturday, Sunday, day of the Christmas break, of the Easter break or of a bank holiday or day appointed for public thanksgiving or mourning must be disregarded. "The Christmas break" means the period beginning with the last week day before Christmas Eve and ending with the first week day after Christmas Day which is not a bank holiday. "The Easter break" means the period beginning with the Thursday before and ending with the Tuesday after Easter Day, and "a bank holiday break" means any bank holiday not included in the Christmas break or Easter break and the period beginning with the last week day before that bank holiday and ending with the next week day which is not a bank holiday.*
